

AGREEMENT

AMONG

SOLETERRE-STRATEGIE DI PACE ONLUS

AND

GULU REGIONAL REFERRAL HOSPITAL (GRRH)

AND

**THE WOUND CARE CENTER OF THE ZUCCHI CLINICAL INSTITUTE (GSD
UNIVERSITY & RESEARCH HOSPITALS) IN MONZA**

This Memorandum of Understanding is signed:

AMONG

The Organization Soletterre strategie di pace ONLUS, registered in via Stresa 6 - 20125 Milan (MI), Italy, Tax Code 9732931015, here represented by the President, Mr Damiano Rizzi, with power of attorney for the execution of this Act, hereinafter simply denominated as " Soletterre"

AND

GULU REGIONAL REFERRAL HOSPITAL, P.O. Box 160, Gulu - Republic of Uganda, here represented by the Director, Dr. James Elima, with power of attorney for the execution of this Act, hereinafter simply denominated as "GRRH"

AND

The Wound Care Center of the Zucchi Clinical Institute in Monza, registered in via Zucchi 24, Italy, Tax Code 00697570968, here represented by Roberto Maria Brambilla, with power of attorney for the execution of this Act, hereinafter simply denominated as "The Wound Care Center"

In the spirit of the contractual freedom of the parties, have agreed as follows:

Article 1- Purpose of Agreement

The purpose of the agreement is establishing the basis of the collaboration among the three parties in order to support the functioning of the local health system in the Department of Gulu, contributing to the affirmation of the right to health for the whole population, in particular in the field of maternal and child health.

Article 2 – Duration of agreement

Except as otherwise provided, this Agreement shall take effect as of the date of signature and shall remain in full force and effect for a period of three years.

Article 3 – Commitment of the parties

The collaboration of the parties will focus on the following areas:

- a. Support to the development of medical and management skills of the GRRH, also through the transfer of knowledge and training through skype meetings and on-site missions;
- b. Promotion of exchanges on specific medical issues selected by all the parties for being of mutual interest;
- c. Share of medical practice and scientific research, within a framework of North-South and South-North collaboration;
- d. Collaboration in the identification of disused machinery in the departments of the Wound Care Center, that can support the provision of health services at the GRRH;

- e. - Promotion of the project implemented by Soletterre in collaboration with the GRRH and peripheral health centers, during the occasions that the Wound Care Center deems appropriate, to increase the possibilities of support towards the intervention;
- f. Evaluation of the opportunity to participate jointly to projects' formulations that can strengthen the collaboration and objective of the MoU.

Article 4 – Modifications of agreement

This Agreement may be supplemented, amended, or modified only by the mutual agreement of the parties.

No supplement, amendment, or modification of this Agreement is allowed unless it is in writing and signed by all parties.

Article 5 – Code of Ethics and Child Protection Policy

The parties take note of the existence of a Child Protection Policy and a Code of Ethics of Soletterre ONLUS. The counterparties agree to respect the general principles of the two documents and guarantee that within the activities covered by the present MoU they have implemented every internal provision aimed at preventing the commission, even attempted, of behaviors sanctioned by the Code of Ethics and the Child Protection Policy. They also undertake to keep these provisions all effectively implemented for the entire duration of the MoU.

Article 6 – Negotiation of problems

The parties agree to negotiate any problems and disputes about the interpretation of the Agreement using a third-party neutral to assist in the negotiations.

The mediator is jointly selected and is asked by the disputing parties to assist them to reach a voluntary agreement. The mediator has no decision making authority and cannot impose a decision. Mediation assistance involves working with the parties to improve their communications, clarify or interpret data, identify key issues to be discussed, design an effective negotiation process, or help to identify or formulate areas of agreement.


